



A Commission Guide: What Does Brussels Pay Commission On?

Dear Brussels Airlines Partner,

Every now and then we are contacted and asked for details about the paid commissions you receive for sales you generated for Brussels Airlines.

To improve transparency please find this summary of the rules:

Brussels will provide commissions solely on the Base Fare of a booking.

No commission will be granted on taxes, fees, surcharges, or any other ancillary charges.

The Base Fare can be viewed by selecting "Show price details" as shown below:

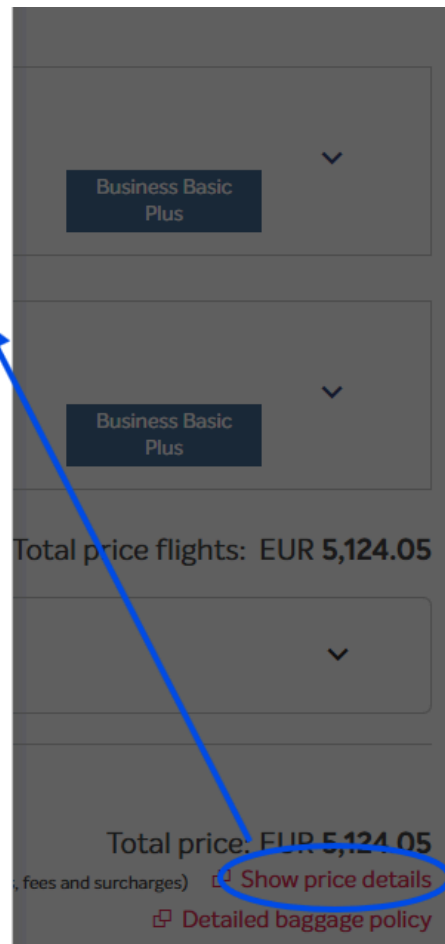

So in this case your commission will be calculated on 3.804 EUR (not 5.124,05 EUR).

The Base Fare can be viewed by the user before or after the purchase of the flight. It is also visible in the Passenger Receipt attached to the Booking Confirmation email. Additionally, the price breakdown, including the Base Fare can be retrieved any time via the Manage My Booking page.
